Minor children in gainful occupation

The Caisse des Dépôts
at your service

It may be that the child for whom you are the legal representative has performed a service: cinema, theatre, advertising, video game competition, exhibition on digital platforms, etc.

In this case, and in accordance with the French Labour Code, the Caisse des Dépôts opens and maintains an account to receive income exclusively from your child's professional activities.

Opening the account

- ❑ The Children in Entertainment Commission (Commission des enfants du spectacle) of the Departmental Directorate of Employment, Labour and Solidarity (DDETS) issues work permits to production companies and modelling agency accreditations. It then sets the portion of remuneration to be paid to the Caisse des Dépôts.
- ❑ Remuneration for children under the age of 16 is paid directly by employers to the Caisse des Dépôts.
- ❑ The blocked account opened in the child's name is created upon receipt of the first payment, following the administrative decision.

Monitoring the child's account

The legal representatives are informed, by post, of payments made into the child's account for each service performed. An annual account statement is sent to them each year.

The Caisse des Dépôts provides

- ❑ **Security**
Its strict neutrality guarantees respect and protection of the rights of minors.
- ❑ **Simplicity and speed of procedures**
The management department transmits a statement of transactions upon request. An account statement is transmitted with each movement of funds.
- ❑ **Retention until the child reaches the age of majority**
The entertainment management department informs the account holder of the availability of their savings and the procedure to follow to obtain restitution of the wages deposited in full.

Articles L 7124-1 and R 7124-1 et seq. of the French Labour Code

In accordance with the general interest mission entrusted to the Caisse des Dépôts, as account keeper, the management department ensures the protection of children's interests and the implementation of a high-quality customer relationship. According to the French Labour Code, the Caisse des Dépôts retains and manages the "savings" of children in the entertainment and modelling industry and child influencers, as well as the earnings of children who compete in video games, until they reach the age of majority.

Your child's account

This account is governed by the French Labour Code and cannot therefore be considered as a current bank account or an investment. It cannot be credited either by you or by any third party other than an employer or a company that has employed your minor child.

Restitution of earnings

The funds may be recovered as soon as your child turns 18. As soon as they reach the age of majority, they are informed that their savings are available and must submit a request for restitution via the online consignment service: <https://consignations.caissedesdepots.fr/mon-compte/>

This fully secure service is simple and fast.

Management of the account is completely free of charge and the sums deposited earn interest throughout the child's minority.

Please notify your change of address

In order to monitor the child's account and receive all useful information, it is vital that you provide us with your up-to-date postal address.
